Dear Secretary,

Please refer D.O. letter No.1(13)/EV/2017 dated 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 (copy enclosed) by Additional Secretary, Expenditure requesting expeditious revision of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC pension cases based upon DP&PW O.M. dated 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 which provides for notional fixation of pay of pensioners under 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix to arrive at the revised pension by Heads of Offices (HOOs).

- 2. It is observed that the progress made in revision of pension is not encouraging. As on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 out of more than 9 lakhs central civil pension cases covered under 7<sup>th</sup> CPC, only 6762 cases have been received in CPAO from Ministries/Departments. Only Ministry of Civil Aviation has been able to revise about 26% (1986/7565) cases, whereas progress in other Ministries is poor. The main reason of slow progress is non-sending of revised cases to the PAOs by the
- The progress and pendencies of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC revision cases are provided by CPAO on the Dashboards of respective Joint Secretaries/Admin in charge and CCAs of Ministries/Departments on CPAO website.

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I request you to draw clear timelines to complete the revision exercise and assue necessary instructions to Heads of Departments / Heads of Offices of your Ministry/Department to forward the revised cases to respective Pay and Accounts Offices (PAOs) expeditiously. The progress of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC pension revisions should also be reviewed regularly in weekly Senior Officers' Meetings (SOM)
