Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, employment generation is a major thrust area of Government of India and employment market information system plays a significant role for bringing inclusiveness in labour market by reducing asymmetry of information. Presently, information on employment & unemployment is gathered from surveys conducted by NSSO and Labour Bureau which provide estimates in isolation which cannot be corroborated from any other source.

2. Statistics on employment generation in the country is also frequently required to respond to Parliament questions, debates, cut-motion, Private Members' bill etc. in addition to presenting employment statistics at International forums like G-20, BRICS, OECD, etc.

3. Keeping in view the requirement of regular information on employment, it has been decided to coordinate and consolidate the data of employment generated under various employment generation schemes run by the Ministries/ Departments. It may also be mentioned that employment generation in various sectors is vital for country's socio-economic development, this aspect has to be an important criterion for any project/ scheme appraisal. As per the Cabinet decision dated 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 (copy enclosed) Ministries are required to assess the employment potential of all schemes, programmes, etc. which is also required to be monitored.

4. I shall therefore, request you to kindly provide the details (physical achievements, sector-wise as per the format annexed) in terms of employment generated (direct & indirect) along with brief write up of the Scheme implemented for employment generation by your ministry for the last two years i.e. for 2014-15 and 2015-16 and also for new schemes yet to be launched. Further, for new schemes on employment generation, efforts should be made to capture data on direct and indirect employment on a regular basis.
