Dear Dr. Sumanathan,

The National Health Mission (NHM) is now in its fourth year with its Sub-Mission NRHM completing eleven years. Under this Mission, the States have reported substantial progress on various initiatives. In order to arrive at a comprehensive understanding of progress of the Mission in States and identify points for remedial actions, if any, Review Missions are undertaken by the Ministry.

One of the important tools for monitoring progress of NHM and validating its strategies is the Annual Common Review Mission (CRM). The Review Mission comprises desk reviews as well as field visits to health facilities, interactions with different stakeholders including citizens and detailed briefings by the State and district authorities.

Nine Common Review Missions (CRMs) undertaken so far have provided valuable understanding of the strategies which were successful and those which warranted mid course adjustments. You would have had the chance of perusing the report of the past CRMs which have been widely disseminated and are also available on the website of NHM.

10th Common Review Mission (CRM) under National Health Mission is scheduled to be held from 4th November to 11th November 2016 in 16 States / UTs namely Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Chandigarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and Uttar Pradesh. For the purpose of CRM, teams are constituted comprising Government Officials, Public Health Experts, Representatives of the Development Partners and Civil Society Organisations.

The teams are envisaged to visit the States (two districts) for a period of five days and conduct extensive field visits followed by detailed State level debriefings culminating in a final report which shall be submitted to the Govt of India. The detailed Terms of Reference of 10th CRM are being emailed to you shortly and the teams shall document progress of NHM broadly in the formats.

The schedule for the 10th CRM is as under:

5 th November 2016	State Briefing at respective State Head Quarters
6 th to 10 th November 2016	Field Visits
11 th November 2016	Preparation of State Report and State de-briefing
