2. Law is an instrument of social change and objective of any State remains to promote and protect the rule of law. The same is only possible by empowering the citizens of this country with the knowledge of their rights and duties and the principles enshrined in the Constitution of India. As a part of initiative in this direction, Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice in collaboration with National Academy of Legal Studies & Research (NALSAR), University of Law is launching an online course on Constitution to create awareness and strengthen the citizens of this country.

The course further seeks to familiarise with the text of the Constitution and leading cases, identify the fundamental policy choices incorporated in the Constitution, examine the historical evolution and understand the post independence constitutional journey, through a series of 15 conceptual videos. The videos shall be available for viewing for a fixed period of six months after the date of registration by the applicants. A certificate of participation shall be automatically generated after any person registers and views the videos on the portal <a href="https://legalaffairs.nalsar.ac.in">https://legalaffairs.nalsar.ac.in</a>.

The registration for the course has been kept free for all the citizens and members of the society for viewing and participation. However, any citizen who wishes to obtain a Certificate of Appreciation or Certificate of Merit, is required to opt for online assessment on a token fee of Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only), which is purely optional:
